
Permanently Deleting Media Files from WordPress

- 1. Sign in to WordPress.
- 2. Click Media on the left side of the screen.




You can now delete files one at a time or in bulk.


- Delete files one at a time

Delete Files One at a Time

- 3. Hover over the file you want to delete.
- 4. Click Delete Permanently.



5. Click **OK** on the confirmation dialog.



Delete Files in Bulk

- 3. Check the boxes next to the files you want to delete.
- 4. Select **Delete Permanently** from the *Bulk Actions* drop-down.
- 5. Click Apply.

Warning: WordPress does not ask for confirmation when using the bulk actions. Please make sure that you have only selected files that should be permanently, irrevocably deleted.
