

Why Does My Calendar Print Without Cell Colors?

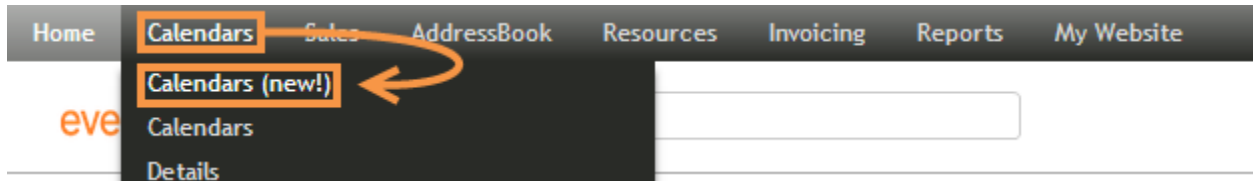

Settings in your browser can prevent calendar background colors from printing correctly. Please follow the appropriate steps below to adjust the settings of your browser.

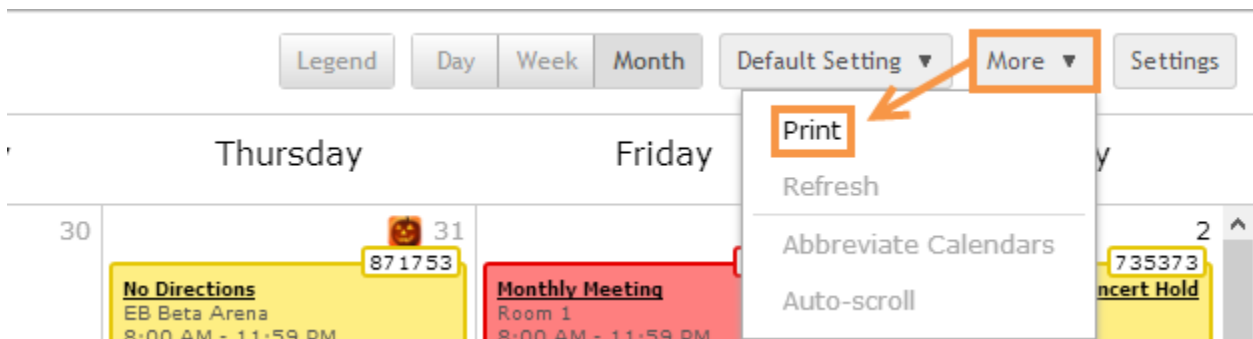

Google Chrome

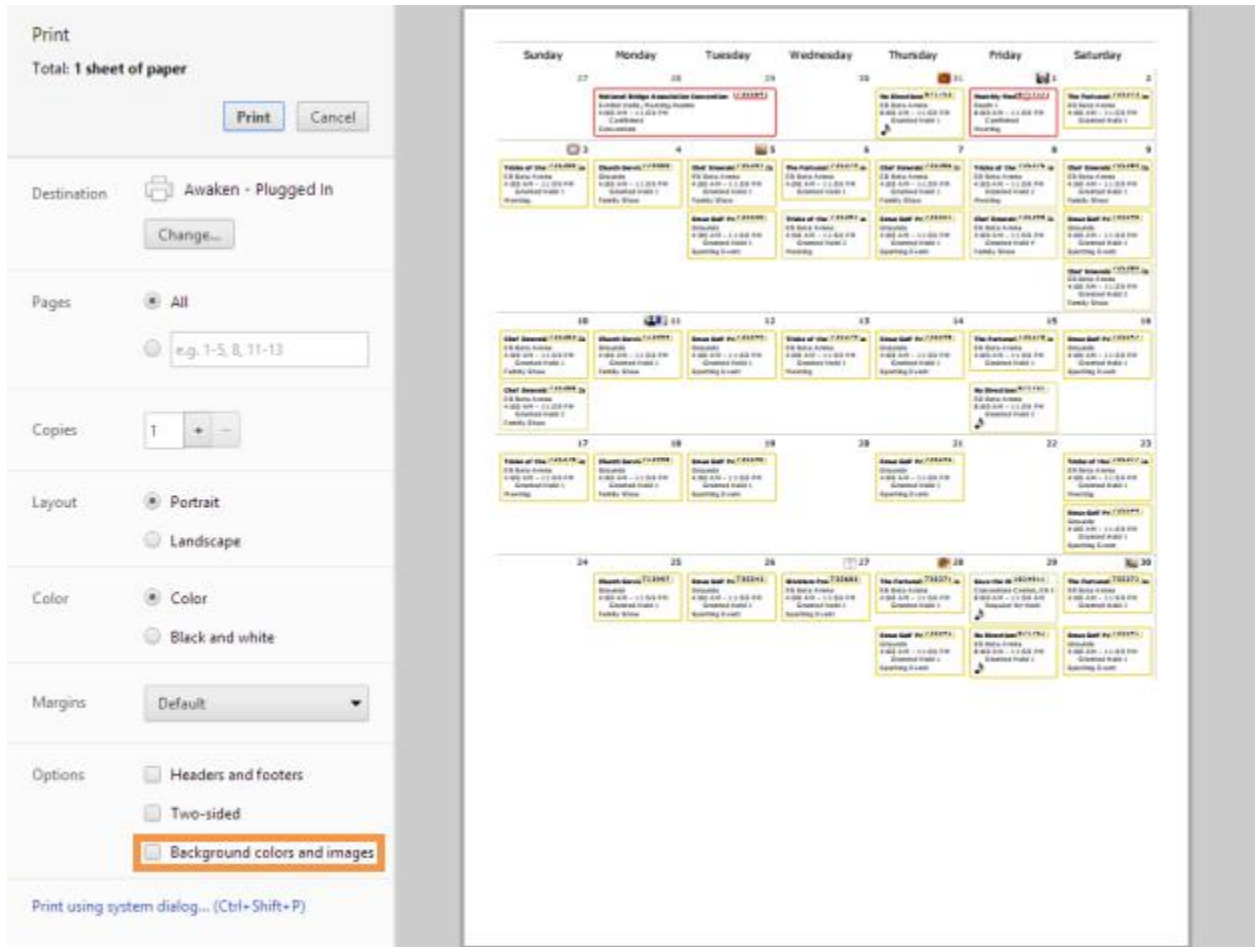
1. Hover over **Calendars**.
2. Click **Calendars (new!)**.



3. Click **More**.
4. Click **Print**.



- 5. Check the box next to **Background colors and images**.



6. Click **Print**.

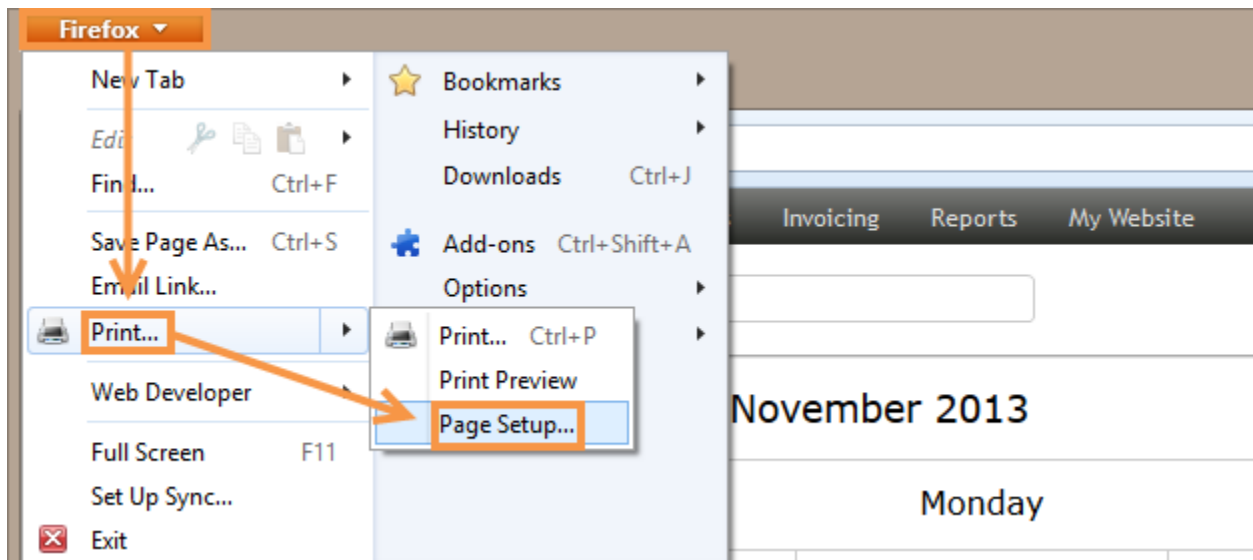

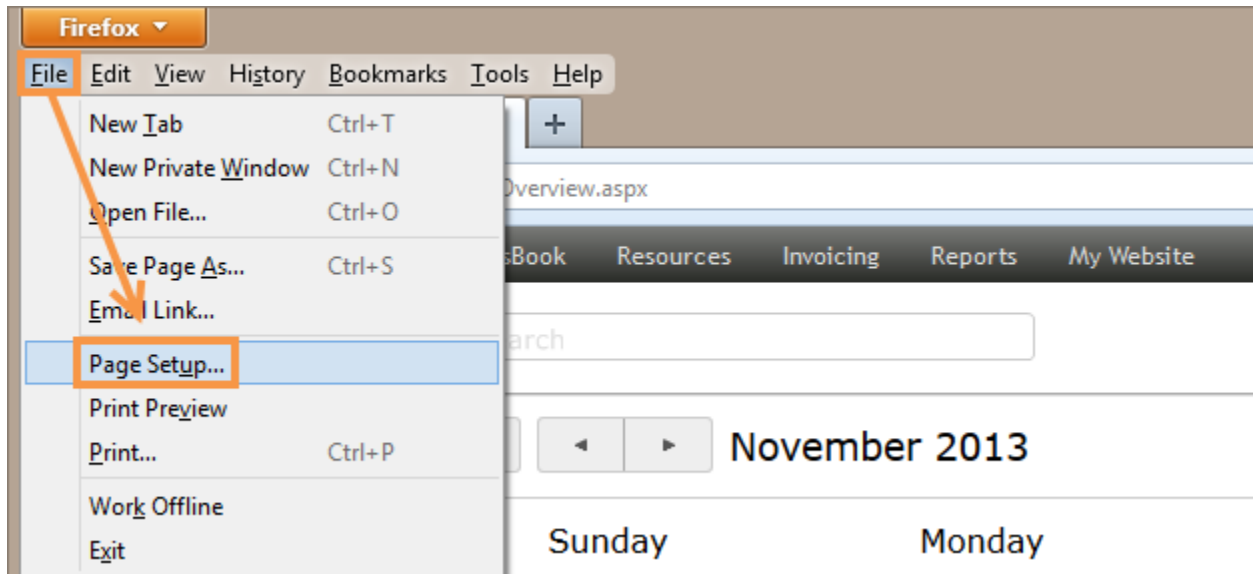

Firefox

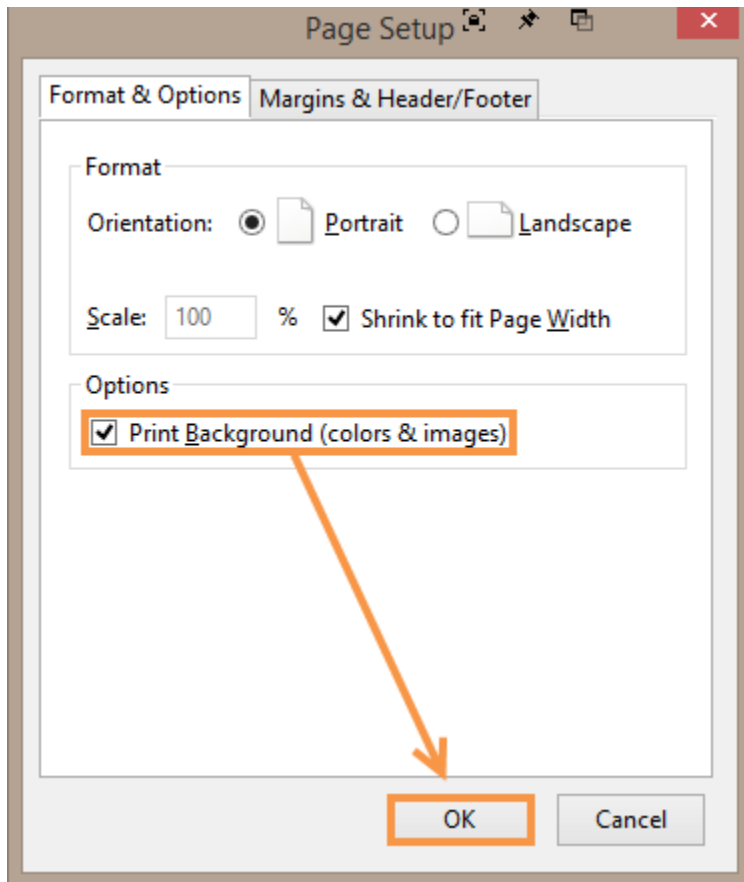
1. There are two ways to open the **Page Setup** window:

 - ii. Click **Page Setup**.

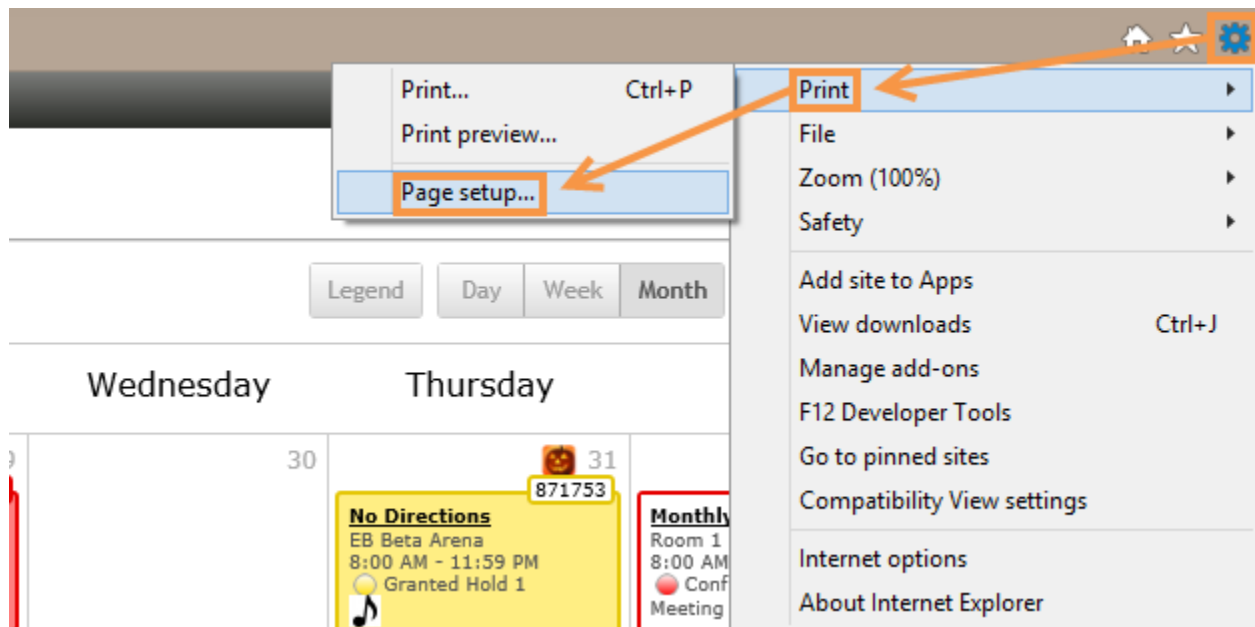


2. Check the box next to **Print Background (colors & images)**.
3. Click **OK**.

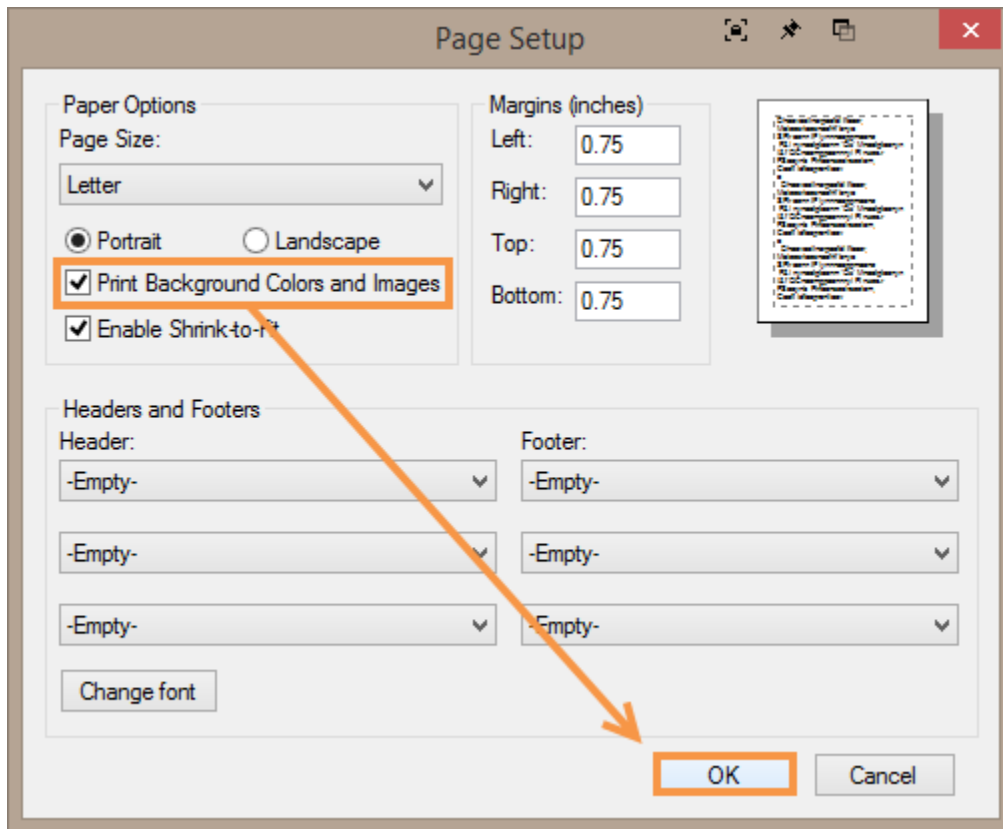


Internet Explorer

2. Hover over **Print**.
3. Click **Page Setup**.

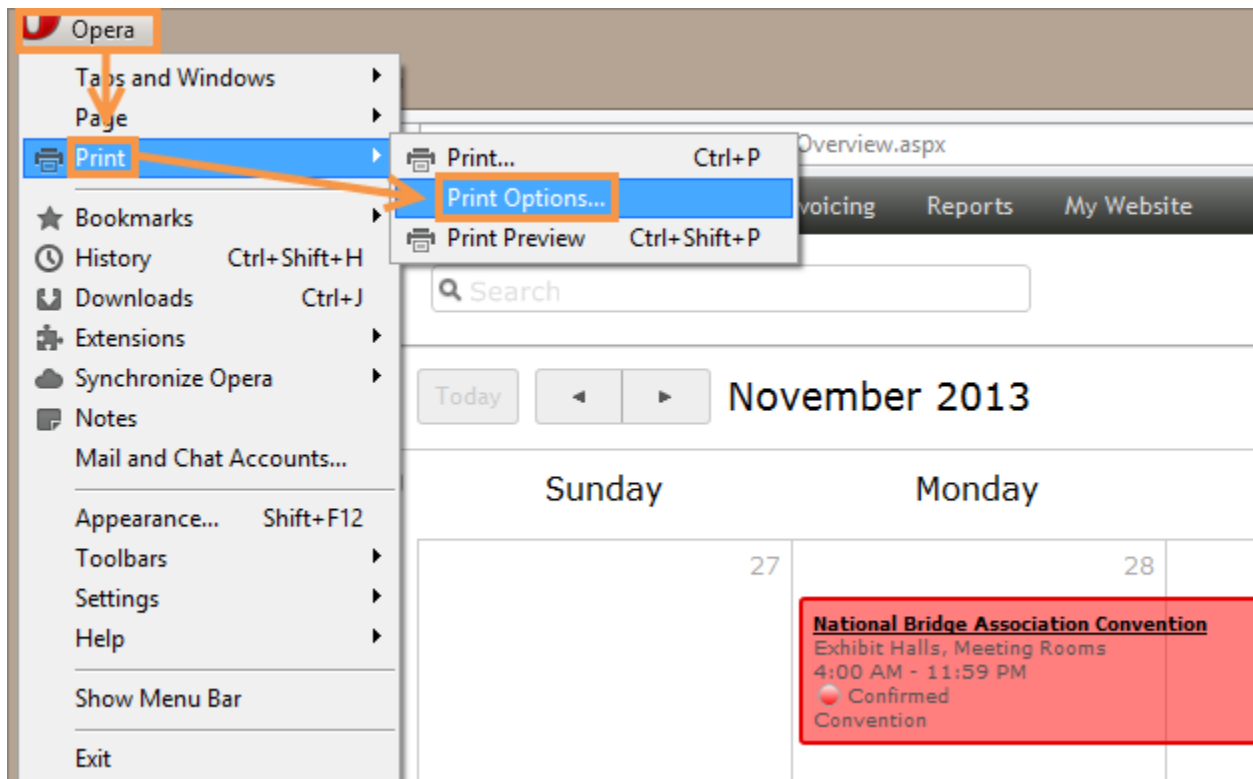


4. Check the box next to **Print Background Colors and Images**.
